This 4BR (or 3BR + Office), 2.5 BA house was built in 1990 and completely gutted and renovated in 2008 with high-end materials, finishes end appliances. The totally remodeled kitchen now features Bosch, Wolf and SubZero appliances, granite countertops, custom cabinetry, and plenty of storage. Details like built-in spice racks, toe-kick storage, pull-outs in cupboards in pantries, two sinks, and an ultra-quiet dishwasher provide the finishing touches to this cook's kitchen. The family room features a vaulted ceiling, Solatube skylights, travertine marble floors, and custom wine bar. Readers and collectors will appreciate the exquisite library/living room with two walls of Floor-to-ceiling built-ins, contemporary gas fireplace, plantation shutters and plenty of natural light. Sleek and chic are the key words for this dining room with its art glass, plantation shutters, chair rail and crown mouldings, and stunning color scheme. In the master suite, you'll find vaulted ceilings, a large walk-in closet with closet system, Solatube skylights, sitting area, and environmentally friendly cork floors. The bathroom has custom cabinetry, granite countertops, double sinks and vanities with storage galore. The walk-in shower has both a rain head and a wall mounted hand show-er. Bedrooms 2, 3 and 4 have either cork or bamboo floors, ceiling fans, crown moulding, and builtins. All interior doors are solid core. Every exterior door end window was replaced with impact resistant glass, and the main entry doors were upgraded to solid mahogany glass, and the main entry doors were upgraded to solid manogany French doors with hurricane locks and impact glass. Double French doors lead from the living space to the screened pool area that in-cludes a built-in gas grill with direct propane connection and is ideal for lounging, outdoor dining, or entertaining. The salt pool has auto-matic pH control and solar heat. A detached oversized single car garage was added in 2006. This air conditioned space can be used as a workshop, studio, or exercise room. The-doors to both garages meet Dade County code for wind resistance. The whole-house backup generator runs on propane and has en automatic transfer switch. A 500 gallon buried propane tank supplies the generator, BBQ grill, fireplace, water heater, clothes dryer and cooktop. Perhaps the most outstanding feature of this home is the amazing park-like gardens that surround it. Payer walkways lead you through native and tropical plants, palms, cypress trees, and butterfly gardens. Benches and a gazebo provide secluded places to sit, relax, and enjoy the peace and tranquility of this tropical paradise. Butterflies and humming-birds dart among the flowers, while songbirds serenade you. The property is recognized as both a Certified Florida Yard and a Certi-fied Backyard Wildlife Habitat. The Water garden attracts herons and egrets. Owls, woodpeckers, cardinals and mockingbirds, to name a few, nest in the trees. This truly is an oasis.
